Psalm 3 (Red Bible, p. 532; Blue Bible, p. 844)

¹ O LORD, how many are my foes! How many rise up against me!

² Many are saying of me, "God will not deliver him." *Selah*

³ But you are a shield around me, O LORD; you bestow glory on me and lift up my head.

⁴ To the LORD I cry aloud, and he answers me from his holy hill. *Selah*

⁵ I lie down and sleep; I wake again, because the LORD sustains me.

⁶ I will not fear the tens of thousands drawn up against me on every side.

⁷ Arise, O LORD! Deliver me, O my God! Strike all my enemies on the jaw; break the teeth of the wicked.

⁸ From the LORD comes deliverance. May your blessing be on your people. *Selah*

"Our habit is to talk *about* God, not *to* him. We love discussing God. But the Psalms resist such discussions. They are provided not to teach us about God but to train us in responding to him. We don't learn the Psalms until we are praying them. . . . Our usual approach to God's word is to ask, What is God saying to me? That is almost always the correct question when reading Scripture. But in the Psalms the question is, How do I answer the God who speaks to me. In the Psalms we do not primarily learn what God *says* to us, but how to honestly, devoutly and faithfully *answer* his words to us."

Questions to Consider as You Respond to the Word of God Preached

1. In what ways do you identify with David in this psalm? Are you experiencing temptation to doubt God's sovereignty and care for you? Where should you turn?
2. Can you think of times when God delivered you in the past? How was that deliverance "surprising?"

1. How did God's Word speak to you today—to bring comfort, challenge or encouragement?
2. How can I pray for you this week?

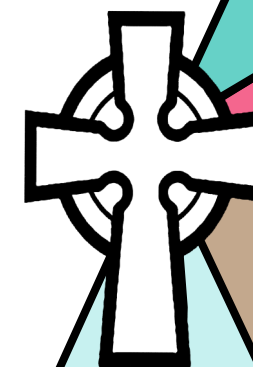
