Church Basics: Lord's Supper

1 Corinthians 11:23-27

²³ For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

1. The ordinances proclaim the Gospel and our connection with Jesus.
2. The Ordinances are the way we begin and continue our relationship with the church.
3. In the Ordinances, the individual believer commits himself or herself to Christ publicly.
4. In the ordinances the individual believer publicly commits themselves to Jesus' people.
5. God speaks through the Ordinances.
6. God uses the ordinances to create the local church.

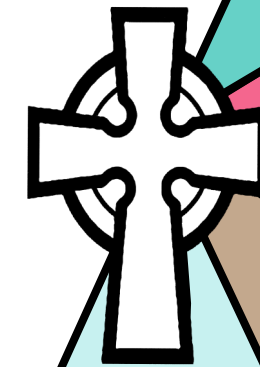
OTHER WAYS TO PARTNER TOGETHER IN THE GOSPEL
