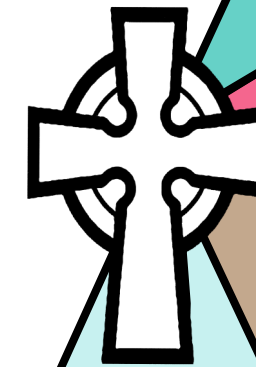
## LIFE TOGETHER THIS SUMMER
