**COVENANT ON DISPLAY:** We would ask each member to prayerfully consider a contribution to the building fund. For more information check the resource table for a flyer.

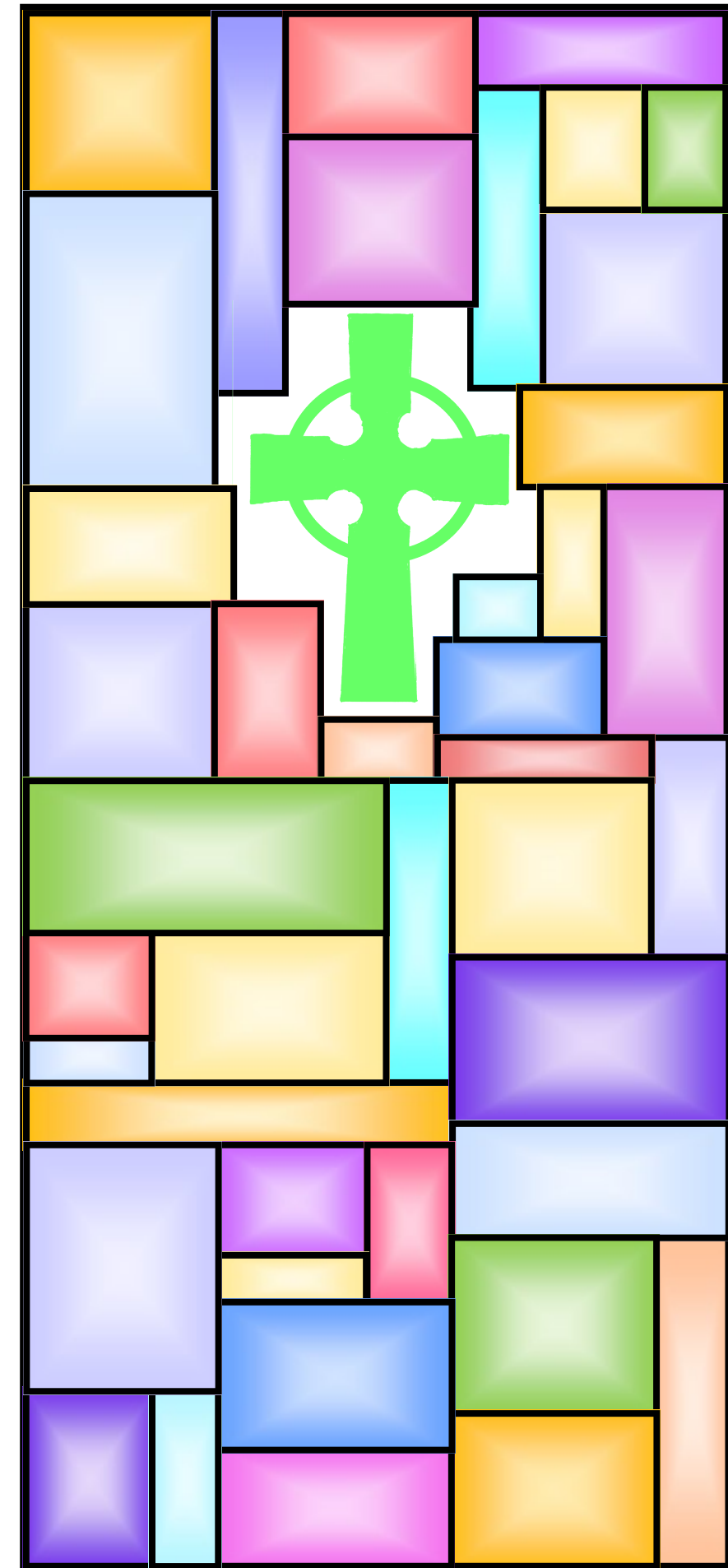
